To Register

Please print all information in black or blue ink. Registration will not be accepted unless completely filled out. **Camper and Parent/Guardian must sign the form.** Mail early for the week of your age group (Fall 2019 school grade). The \$75 deposit must be mailed with your registration. (Please see "Cancellations" regarding refunds). You may mail your total amount due if this is more convenient for you. Make check or money order payable to Camp Victory. We do not accept credit cards for camp registration fees. Please keep this information sheet for your reference.

Acknowledgment

Your registration will be acknowledged by email (if provided). Please add registration@campvictoryal.org to your approved contacts to avoid emails going to spam/junk. We also try to confirm by email or phone call during the week prior to arrival. Please legibly print a valid email address on the registration form. You may call to confirm/check on status.

Cancellations

If it is necessary for you to cancel a registration, please contact us as soon as possible; we often have waiting lists. We will refund your registration fee if you let us know at least 7 days before your scheduled arrival (otherwise the deposit is non-refundable.)

Camp Fees

Full Price \$260

Send in a **\$75 registration deposit** and pay balance upon arrival. You may send the total amount if desired. Deposits are deducted from the total fee and must be received to reserve a place in camp. Bible Lesson credit (\$60) will be deducted at registration and cannot be used as deposit. See below for other discounts.

Early Bird Discount

Register by March 31 and save **\$10** (applies to your balance not the registration deposit). To receive this discount, your registration must be postmarked by March 31. Please remember the discount date of March 31 does not guarantee space available in the week you desire. Register early!

Multiple Child Discount

If you are sending multiple children (3 or more) from the same immediate family, you will receive the following discount (Bible lesson discounts still apply):
1st & 2nd child – pay full price (no discount)
3rd child & more -- \$50 discount for 3rd child & more
Please indicate on the registration form or call if mailing forms separately.

Scholarship Campers

For those doing Bible Lessons for scholarships -- **Do Not Wait** until you have completed the lessons to send in your registration. The week you want to attend may already be full. The deadline for starting lessons—January 31st; the deadline for completion—April 15th. Please note that mailing in your camp registration does not enroll you in the Bible lessons.

Arrival/Departure

Check-in **Monday** between 10:00 and 11:30 AM.
Check-out **Saturday** between 9:00 and 10:00 AM.
(Times are Central Time)

Please be aware that the Check In process takes approximately 45 minutes.

What to Bring

- Bible, notebook, pen/pencil
- Pillow; sleeping bag or sheets for bunk bed
- Towels & toiletries
- Modest clothing & swimsuit (**See Dress Code**)
- Closed-toed shoes for climbing wall
- Set of clothes that can get dirty for games, etc.
- Camera (cell phones not allowed)
- Medications in original container (**see below**)
- Spending money (**see below**)
- Optional: flashlight, sunscreen, raincoat, bug spray, fishing tackle

Please Do Not Bring cell phones, cellular enabled watches, tablets, electronic games, ipods/mp3, or any other electronic devices; weapons; or any kind of tobacco, alcohol or other drugs.

Dress Codes

General: Please dress modestly and neatly in keeping with high Christian standards. Clothing must cover all undergarments. Please avoid extreme dress, hairstyles and jewelry. Please do not wear clothing that portrays suggestive or derogatory pictures and messages, including advertising of alcohol, tobacco, etc. Modest swimsuits: one-piece or tankinis (no bikinis, no bare midriffs); casual clothes for daily activities; we prefer fingertip length shorts (or longer). We reserve the right to restrict any clothing deemed inappropriate.

Detailed Dress Code for the weeks of:

June 24-29, July 1-6, and July 22-27:

Clothing must cover all undergarments. Shoulder straps should be at least 2 inches in width. Clothing should not be skin tight or revealing. There are to be no bare midriffs; no sagging waistlines, please. Only fingertip length shorts (or longer) are permitted. Dress/skirts (including slits) should be no shorter than the top of the knee. Both the "general" and "detailed" dress codes will be enforced during these weeks. The "general" dress code will apply to all other weeks. We reserve the right to restrict any clothing deemed inappropriate.

Medications

We will not dispense any camper's prescription or over-the-counter medications if they are not in the original container from the pharmacy, with the child's name, drug, dosage and date clearly indicated.

All medications must be checked in at Registration and kept in First Aid. We keep basic First Aid supplies on hand (see registration form).

Spending Money

We have a snack shop and camp store for campers. For convenience and safety, campers purchase a \$10 "snack card" and deposit any extra money in the camp "bank" on Monday at registration. Any money left over is returned at the end of the week. Campers may make purchases in our Camp Store with their "bank" money. Our Camp Store has a variety of books, posters, souvenirs and T-shirts (\$10-\$18).

Roommate Preference

You may indicate 1 or 2 names on your registration. We will honor this if possible. Also please indicate if you are coming with a church group.

Homesickness

In case of extreme homesickness, we will contact the parent to notify them of the situation and ask them to recommend a course of action.

Lost & Found

Please be sure names are on clothing and other belongings such as cameras, Bibles, etc. Please contact camp office and clearly identify lost items that you want returned to you; we ask that you pay postage. Items not called for within 30 days will be given away.

Missionary Offerings

Each week we have a missionary speaker at camp who presents a special project related to his work. We receive a special offering for this project each week.

Highlights DVD

Every camper will receive a DVD with highlights of their week at camp.

Food Allergies
